MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING MINUTES Indigent Appeal Hearings January 26, 2018

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve and sign the Veteran Office space lease at 625 Fremont Ave. Rupert, Idaho, located within the Duane Smith Annex Building. Commissioner McClellan voiced a second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to amend the agenda as allowed by I.C. 74-204 (4) (c) to allow for election of a co-chairman of the Board of Commissioners as the Board had not done so and she had just now realized the need to do such. A second was voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried. Commissioner McClellan moved to nominate Sheryl Koyle as co-chairman. Commissioner Moore called for a second. Motion died for lack of a second. Commissioner Koyle moved to nominate Kent McClellan as co-chairman with a second voiced by Commissioner Moore. Commissioner Koyle voiced aye, Commissioner Moore voiced aye, and Commissioner McClellan voiced nay. Motion carried.
