



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

March 11, 2019

The meeting was opened with the recital of the **Pledge of Allegiance** and a prayer at 8:30 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Clerk Page.

Renee Waite, Idaho Dept. of Juvenile Corrections and Dixie Tate, Mini-Cassia Juvenile Probation, were present to give a review of the statistics for the 2018 Annual Idaho Juvenile Justice report.

Lyle Santos, Total Waste Management; Cleo Gallegos, City of Heyburn Mayor; and Dick Galbraith, City of Heyburn Councilman, were present to ask the Board for a waiver of transfer station fees for spring cleanup dumping for one week. The Board will take the request under advisement and decide upon it next Monday.

Deputy Clerk Dockstader presented Applications for County Aid.

Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman inquired on behalf of Bob West if the Board would like to release their lien against a property. The Board declined his request.

Commissioner Koyle **moved to approve the Certificate of Residency** with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner McClellan read the proposed proclamation for April to be considered as Fair Housing Month. Commissioner Schenk **moved to proclaim April as Fair Housing Month** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

The Board read the request for a donation to the Veterans of Foreign Wars located at 554 Hiland Ave. in Burley, Idaho, that they received in their correspondence.

The Board discussed the IAC Scholarship Fund and funeral flowers.

The Board reviewed the Mini-Cassia Veteran Service Officer monthly report.

Commissioner Koyle **moved to set August 26, 2019, at 11 AM for the FY2020 public budget hearing** and approval with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner reports were given.

Kathy Uker, Region IV Development, along with Buildings & Grounds Admin. Thomson presented before the Board to discuss the Section 504 Transition Plan.


