



MINIDOKA COUNTY  
COMMISSIONER MEETING  
MINUTES

March 22, 2019

The meeting was opened at 9:11 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, Clerk Page, and Deputy Clerk Dockstader.

This special meeting was for the purpose of canvassing the votes of the March 12, 2019, election for the general obligation school bond and to hear appeals on denials of county aid.

Commissioner Koyle moved to convene as a Board of Canvassers pursuant to I.C. 34-1205 with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner McClellan read aloud the results of the general obligation joint school bond election held on March 12, 2019, as presented by Clerk Page. Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the election results as presented and stated with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to exit the meeting as a Board of Canvassers with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to recess until 10:15 AM with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

10:15 AM Commissioner Schenk moved to come out of recess and reconvene as the Board of County Commissioners with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried. Commissioner Koyle was not present for this hearing.



101979, 2018-94 This appeal was set to be heard at 10:15 AM. The appellant and the widow of the patient failed to appear knowing that the appellant's hospital claim had been financially settled by the widow. Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman stated the basis of this appeal on the record. Commissioner Schenk moved to deny the appeal based upon the fact that no one is present to contest, and no new information, and on the same basis that we denied it initially, with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.
