MINUTES

April 26, 2019

The meeting was opened at 9:00 AM. The pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a prayer.

2019-1: This appeal was set to be heard at 10:15 AM. The appellant was not present for this hearing. Motion carried at 10:16 AM.
