



## MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

May 13, 2019

The meeting was opened with the recital of the **Pledge of Allegiance** and a prayer at 8:30 AM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Goodman, and Clerk Page.

Terrie Denker was present as a member of the public to listen to JoAnne Schenk regarding negotiating account balances. Mrs. Schenk did not show as scheduled but did reschedule to next week.

Deputy Clerk Dockstader presented **Applications for County Aid**.

2019-62 Commissioner Schenk moved to deny due to no interview so we do not know whether a Minidoka resident, obligated county, medical necessity, last resource, or if medically indigent with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

2019-43 Commissioner Koyle moved to deny due to no interview so we do not know if applicant is a resident, if we are the obligated county, last resource, or if they are medically indigent with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed their **correspondence**. The Board received a letter from the Idaho Dept. of Commerce indicating they need documentation for proof of ownership of the fire engine. Commissioner McClellan will drop a copy of the letter off to West End Fire Dept.

Commissioner Schenk moved to sign the **final counter offer letter** to Mr. Noriega with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the **minutes** of May 6, 2019 with changes with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schenk moved to approve **claims and payroll** with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Coroner Bourn was present to request approval for Minidoka County to enter into a **Mutual Aid Agreement with Cassia County regarding coroner services**. Commissioner Koyle moved that we approve the signing of the Mutual Aid Agreement between Minidoka and Cassia County regarding the Coroner's office with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried.

The Board discussed **nomination for a medical consultant** for South Central Public Health District. No nominations were made.

Janie Rutschke, Information Technology, presented before the Board to discuss a **new email and internet policy**. Recommended revisions will be looked at and discussed with department heads.

Each **Commissioner gave a report** regarding the meetings that they had recently attended.


