



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

June 12, 2018

The meeting was opened at 9:00 AM as a joint board meeting between Minidoka and Cassia Counties.

Present for this meeting were: Minidoka County Commissioners Moore, McClellan, and Koyle; Cassia County Commissioners Kunau, Christensen, and Darrington; Minidoka County Clerk Page; and Cassia County Clerk Larsen and Deputy Auditor Evans.

Members of the public present: Wayne Schenk, Kerry McMurray, and Leonard Beck.

The purpose of this special meeting was to hear proposed budget presentations from the departments that are shared between Minidoka and Cassia County and along with such, each county presented their separate district court budget for convenience of the Fifth District Court Judge and Trial Court Administrator.

9:00 AM Mini-Cassia Public Defenders' proposed budget was presented to both county boards by Public Defense Attorney Dennis Byington.

9:15 AM Minidoka County District Court's proposed budget was presented to the Minidoka County board by Clerk Page with input from the Fifth Judicial District Administrative District Judge Eric J. Wildman and Trial Court Administrator Shelly Tubbs.

9:30 AM Cassia County District Court's proposed budget was presented to the Cassia County board by Clerk Larsen with input from the Fifth Judicial District Administrative District Judge Eric J. Wildman and Trial Court Administrator Shelly Tubbs.

9:45 AM Mini-Cassia Adult Misdemeanor Probation's proposed budget was presented to both county boards by Director Amber Prewitt.

10:00 AM Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center's (MCJC) proposed budget was presented to both county boards by Cassia County Sheriff Heward, MCJC Director George Warrell, and MCJC Administrator Dan Renz. This budget request was confirmed.

10:15 AM Mini-Cassia Juvenile Probation's proposed budget was presented to both county boards by Chief of Probation Dixie Tate-Dennis via telephone.

10:30 AM Mini-Cassia Juvenile Detention's proposed budget was presented to both county boards by Director Trent Bodily.

10:45 AM Mini-Cassia Veterans Advisory Board's proposed budget for the Mini-Cassia Veteran Service Officer's proposed budget was presented by Mini-Cassia Veterans Advisory Board Secretary Ron Beedle and Mini-Cassia Veteran Service Officer Chuck Driscoll.

Deputy Auditor Evans requested an executive session regarding a personnel issue. Commissioner Koyle moved to enter into Executive Session pursuant to I.C. 74-206 (1) (b) with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Commissioner Moore called for roll call. Commissioner Koyle voiced an aye, Commissioner McClellan voiced an aye, and Commissioner Moore voiced an aye. Motion carried. Cassia County Commissioner's also entered into executive session. The general tenor of the session was concerns voiced regarding an employee. Commissioner

Koyle moved to exit executive session with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried. Cassia County also exited the executive session.

Both boards also discussed salary increases.
