



MINIDOKA COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING MINUTES

June 27, 2019

The meeting was opened at 1:32 PM.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner McClellan, Commissioner Schenk, Prosecuting Attorney Stevenson, and Clerk Page.

Commissioner McClellan moved to enter into executive session under Idaho Code 74-206 (1) (f) with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Commissioner McClellan voiced an aye and Commissioner Schenk voiced an aye. Motion carried. Commissioner Koyle joined the meeting during executive session. Commissioner Schenk moved to exit out of executive session with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

Cassia County Commissioners Beck, Searle, and Kunau joined the meeting along with Admin. Kerry McMurray, Deputy Auditor Heather Evans, and Deputy Clerk Sharene Ahlin.

Joint budget hearings began at 1:50 PM.

Mini-Cassia Public Defender budget: Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the Public Defender's overall budget at \$924,865.00, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried. Cassia County Commissioners then voiced their motion to approve.

Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center budget: Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center budget at \$3,548,471.00 for the 2020 fiscal year with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Cassia County Commissioners then voiced their motion to approve.

Mini-Cassia Veteran Service Officer budget: Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the Veteran Service Officer budget at \$37,958.39, with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried. Cassia County Commissioners then voiced their motion to approve.

Mini-Cassia Juvenile Probation budget: Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the juvenile probation budget for FY2020 at \$765,082.50, with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried. Cassia County Commissioners then voiced their motion to approve.

Mini-Cassia Juvenile Detention budget: Commissioner Koyle moved to approve the 2020 fiscal year budget for juvenile detention at \$1,080,822 total with a second voiced by Commissioner Schenk. Motion carried. Cassia County Commissioners then voiced their motion to approve.

Mini-Cassia Misdemeanor Probation budget: Commissioner Schenk moved to approve the misdemeanor probation budget at \$922,235.00 for FY2020 with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.


