

MINUTES

Mini-Cassia Executive Board of Juvenile Probation

Tuesday, January 10, 2023

7:30 AM

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Schaeffer at 7:30 AM.

Present for the meeting: Minidoka Commissioner Schaeffer, Minidoka Sheriff Pinther, Minidoka Prosecutor Stevenson, Minidoka Juvenile Probation Director Tate, Juvenile Detention Center Director Bodily, Minidoka Clerk Page and Minidoka Deputy Clerk Ramsey, Cassia Commissioner Searle, Cassia Prosecutor Larsen, Cassia Undersheriff Thompson, and Cassia Deputy Clerk Wallace.

Sheriff Pinther moved to approve the minutes from December 13, 2022, with a second voiced by Commissioner Searle. Motion carried.

Juvenile Judge Pittard was excused.

Juvenile Probation Director Tate reported: that they ended 2022 with 211 petition citations; 43 probation violations; and \$26,000 restitution in Minidoka County; 94 petition citations; 19 probation violations; \$6,000 restitution; and 31 diversion cases for Cassia County. SUD program had 30 youth participate. They have a POST in-service on officer safety which will get all the JPO staff POST certified. There will be a grant funded parenting program starting in February, one in Spanish and one in English. She also reported on the WILD program, difficult to find projects in the winter. There will be a program on the 17th at the Little Theater in Burley with Gabe Salazar on kindness, bullying and overall mental health.

IDJC District 5 Liaison Renee Waite was excused.

Director Bodily reported that they have 5 residents, 3 Minidoka, and 2 Cassia.

Prosecutor Stevenson reported that he wanted a clarification, to be able to let the judges know, who is legal counsel for the jail and the detention center. Minidoka's prosecuting office has always done the legal counsel for the hiring, firing and advising for the Detention Center and Cassia's prosecuting office has always done the same for the Mini-Cassia Jail. He asked the Board for their opinion. It was agreed that Minidoka will handle the Detention Center with the assistance of Cassia when needed and, Cassia will handle the jail with the assistance of Minidoka when needed.

Sheriff Pinther thanked everyone for the assistance at the High School incident.

Commissioner Searle moved to adjourn the meeting with a second voiced by Commissioner Searle. Motion carried.
