This special meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing the May 17, 2022 Primary Election results.

Present for this meeting were: Commissioner Koyle, Commissioner McClellan and Clerk Page.

Commissioner McClellan moved to convene as a Board of Canvassers of Election pursuant to I.C. 34-1205 and I.C. 34-1410, with a second voiced by Commissioner Koyle. Motion carried.

At 8:41 A.M. Commissioner Koyle moved to accept the canvass of votes for May 17, 2022 Primary Election with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

11:36 A.M. Commissioner Koyle moved to reopen the meeting of May 19, 2022, with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Present were: Commissioner McClellan and Commissioner Koyle via telephone along with Clerk Page and Deputy Clerk Ramsey present.

Commissioner Koyle moved to re-convene as a Board of Canvassers of Election pursuant to I.C. 34-1205 and I.C. 34-1410, with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.



Commissioner Koyle moved to correct the number of ballots cast in Heyburn 1, Precinct 003, from 298 to 297 giving a corrected county wide total number of ballots cast as 3,284, with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.
