

**MINUTES**  
**Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center Committee Meeting**  
**MAY 24, 2022**  
**8:00 A.M.**

The meeting was called to order by Prosecutor Stevenson at 7:59 A.M.

Minidoka County representatives present were: Commissioner McClellan, Sheriff Pinther, and Prosecutor Stevenson.

Cassia County representatives present were: Commissioner Searle, Prosecutor Larson and Undersheriff Thompson.

Others present were: Director Renz, Director Prewitt, Cassia County Deputy Clerk Wallace, JDC Director Bodily, Minidoka Deputy Clerk Ramsey and Minidoka County Clerk Page.

Sheriff Pinther **moved to approve the minutes of May 10, 2022**, with a second voiced by Undersheriff Thompson. Motion carried.

**Criminal Justice Center – Director Renz**

Director Renz reported that they have 142 in custody: 41 Cassia, 46 Minidoka, 37 IDOC, 13 US Marshals, 2 Twin Falls and 1 ICE, which makes 53 beds rented. Sheriff Pinther **made a motion to conditionally approve Klay Kunzler and Paul Gibson**, with a second voiced by Commissioner Searle. Motion carried. Director Renz reported that if revenues maintain at \$105,000 a month, May through August, not including September, they will make their projections for the year.

**Adult Misdemeanor Probation – Director Prewitt**

Director Prewitt reported: They have 1052 active probationers with 366 on pretrial release. Nothing new to report, pretrial officer is doing good and is headed to POST.

**Juvenile Detention Center – Director Bodily**

Director Bodily reported that they have 9 residents, 4 Minidoka and 5 Cassia. They are fully staffed and doing good.

### **Criminal Justice Center Budget – Clerk Larsen**

Deputy Clerk Wallace reported that at 64% of the year gone: Misdemeanor Probation expenditures are at 58% and revenue is looking great; jail expenditures are at 61% and revenue is at 44.21%, with the jail trust at **-\$191,827.97**. Director Renz reported that they have billed \$335,263 for February and March that has not been received yet.

### **Juvenile Detention Center Budget – Clerk Page**

Clerk Page reported that Juvenile Detention has \$146,296 in the account.
