Director Prewitt reported that they have 997 active probationers with 362 on pretrial release.

Clerk Larsen reported that at 78% of the year gone: Misdemeanor Probation expenditures are at 70% and revenues are at 69%; jail expenditures are at 75% and revenue is at 69.52%.
