

MINUTES
Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center Committee Meeting
August 23, 2022
8:00 A.M.

The meeting was called to order by Prosecutor Stevenson at 7:59 A.M.

Minidoka County representatives present were: Commissioner McClellan, Sheriff Pinther, and Prosecutor Stevenson.

Cassia County representatives present were: Commissioner Searle, and Undersheriff Thompson.

Others present were: Cassia County Deputy Clerk Wallace, and Clerk Evans, Director Renz, JDC Director Bodily, Minidoka Deputy Clerk Ramsey, Minidoka Clerk Page and Cassia Administrator McMurray.

Commissioner McClellan **moved to approve the minutes of August 9, 2022**, with a second voiced by Undersheriff Thompson. Motion carried.

Criminal Justice Center – Director Renz

Director Renz reported: that there are 142 in custody: 42 Cassia, 43 Minidoka, 44 IDOC, 11 US Marshals, and 1 Twin Falls, which makes 56 beds rented; They are still down 3 staff positions. Revenues are looking good, IDOC is processing the June check which will bring them up to 89% revenue and, with the billing for July will bring them to 99%.

The roof bid was opened in the Cassia County Commissioner meeting with Roberts Roofing being the only bid at \$119,000. Commissioner Searle **moved to ratify the bid from Roberts Roofing in the amount of \$119,000**, with a second voiced by Undersheriff Thompson. Motion carried.

Director Renz presented Addendum #4 from Summit Food. Commissioner Searle **moved to approve Addendum #4 from Summit Food** with a second voiced by Commissioner McClellan. Motion carried.

Adult Misdemeanor Probation – Director Prewitt

Director Prewitt reported: Currently they have 1022 active probationers with 367 on pretrial; had an officer graduated POST; have two trainings coming up and will send half of the officers to each; Averhealth's live date will be October 3rd; new calling

system; and budgets are doing great with 80% expenditures and 105% revenue with 89% of the year gone.

Juvenile Detention Center – Director Bodily

Director Bodily reported that they have 2 residents currently, they will be transferring them out tomorrow and getting ready for a shut down for a generator transfer.

Criminal Justice Center Budget – Clerk Larsen

Deputy Clerk Wallace reported they are excited with the jail revenues and that she agrees with the numbers that Director Prewitt reported. The trust is \$536,009.02

Deputy Clerk Evans reported that they will be amending the budget for roof repair and the premium overtime and flood repair. ICRMP paid \$123,093.89 for the flood repair.

Juvenile Detention Center Budget – Clerk Page

Clerk Page reported that JDC is at 72% expended with 89% of the year gone. The trust balance is \$516,773.00.
